Preliminary Plan Approved For Holston Home Expansion

The preliminary plan for Holston United Methodist Home for Children's proposed Christian Life Center, to be located on a sloping tract of Holston's property between the Beacon School and a residential group home for clients, was also approved.

The project will include an expansion of the existing parking area.

Holston Home President & CEO Bradley Williams said previously that he hopes the facility will not only serve as a worship center, but also as a social hub for the youth. Holston Home officials initially announced plans for the facility in 2015.
